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### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- Be a current resident of **Pinal County**
- Be a **high school senior**
- Plan to attend an **accredited college or trade school**

**Disbursement of scholarship funds is contingent upon proof of acceptance and enrollment in an accredited college or trade school, and completed five (5) hours of community service or donate fifty (50) cans to a local food bank (receipt must be submitted). Only one check for the full amount of the scholarship will be issued, after required information is received.** Note, in previous years the Committee has elected to award more funds to students attending a university. If you list a university and your proof of enrollment list a junior college or trade school, your scholarship will be reduced.

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### **Application Requirements**

Submit a **completed application** along with the following attachments:

- **Two (2) letters of recommendation:**
  - One from a teacher, counselor, or principal at your current school
  - One from a community member
- **A photocopy of your current high school transcript**
- **A typed essay (500–words) on the topic:**  
**“How I have applied and intend to apply the Core Values of Cesar Chavez.”**
